Packed Lunch Advice

A healthy lunch helps children stay energised and ready to learn. Aim to include a wholegrain carbohydrate option (such as wholemeal bread, wraps or pasta), a source of protein like chicken, tuna, egg, hummus or cheese, plus some fruit or vegetables.

While pre-made snacks can be convenient for busy families, many are highly processed and may contain lots of salt and sugar. Simple homemade options can help provide a more balanced lunch.

Easy Lunchbox Ideas:

- Wholemeal sandwich or wrap with chicken, tuna, egg or cheese
- Pasta salad with sweetcorn or cucumber
- Hummus with carrot or cucumber sticks
- Cheese cubes with wholegrain crackers
- Fresh fruit such as apples, grapes, berries or banana
- Yoghurt

The Great British Clean Up started this week and our Eco Council did their bit by litter picking near school.



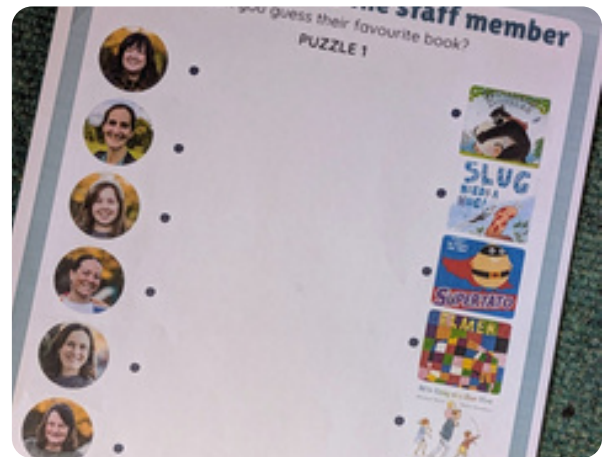
Explorers had the best time at Pizza Express in Oxted where they learnt how to make a Margherita pizza.

PENALTY NOTICE INFORMATION

Just to remind parents/carers that if they take their children out of school without authority for 5 or more days (which do not have to be consecutive), then the following will apply:

1. If you have not incurred a penalty notice relating to this child/children in a rolling 3 year period since 19 August 2024, then the penalty notice will be charged at the rate of £160.00, per parent/carer per child, if paid within 28 days. This will be reduced to £80.00 if paid within 21 days of receipt of the notice. Failure to pay the Penalty Notice will result in Surrey County Council considering legal proceedings against you in the Magistrates Court.
2. If you have incurred a penalty notice relating to this child/children since 19 August 2024, the rolling 3 year period will be activated from the date of the first penalty notice and the second penalty notice will be charged at the flat rate of £160.00, per parent/carer per child, if paid within 28 days. There will be no reduction for payment within 21 days. Failure to pay the Penalty Notice will result in Surrey County Council considering legal proceedings against you in the Magistrates Court.
3. If you have incurred 2 penalty notices relating to this child/children in the rolling 3 year period since the first penalty notice was issued, then you will NOT receive a third penalty notice – Surrey County Council will have no option but to consider a prosecution, per parent/carer per child, in the Magistrates Court under s 444 Education Act 1996.

Surrey County Council is not responsible for authorising pupil absence and therefore cannot withdraw any Penalty Notice requests without the written permission of the Headteacher.

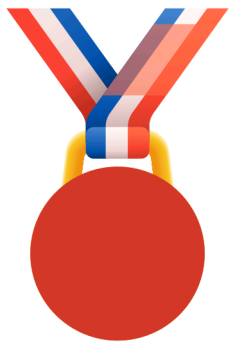

Online Safety News

New kidsonlinesafetywebsite launched as part of government campaign

To mark Safer Internet Day on 16 February 2026, the Government launched a brand-new Kids Online Safety website, designed to help families feel more confident in guiding their children's online experiences.

This new resource has been shaped around the real concerns shared by families across the UK, helping to make everyday conversations about online behaviour simpler, more confident and more meaningful.

Developed with experts like Parent Zone and Internet Matters, it provides parents with simple conversation starters, age-appropriate advice on risks, and guidance on setting up parental controls.

The website is designed to support families and encourage regular conversations about what they're seeing online, asking simple questions, like "who shared this" and "why?". Based on parents' main concerns and needs, it provides:

- tips for parents' conversations with their children
- actions to support each stage of their child's life
- parental controls information

The website will also signpost to trusted resources from charities and third parties, where parents can access other forms of support (like speaking to an expert).

The website will continue to grow and be developed this year, supporting the Online Safety Act and wider government aims.
