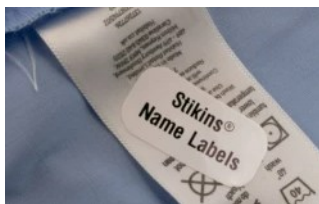
Y2 Music Festival

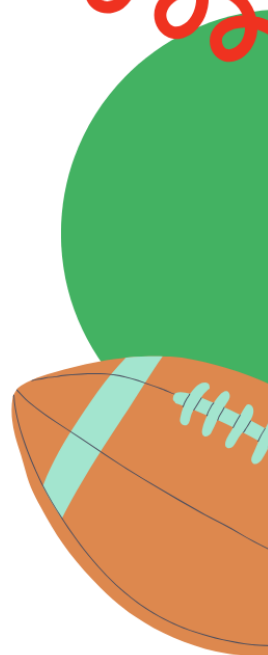
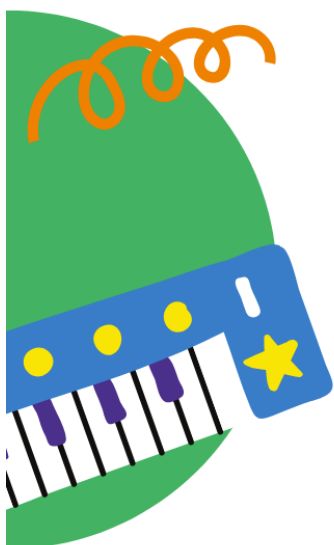
